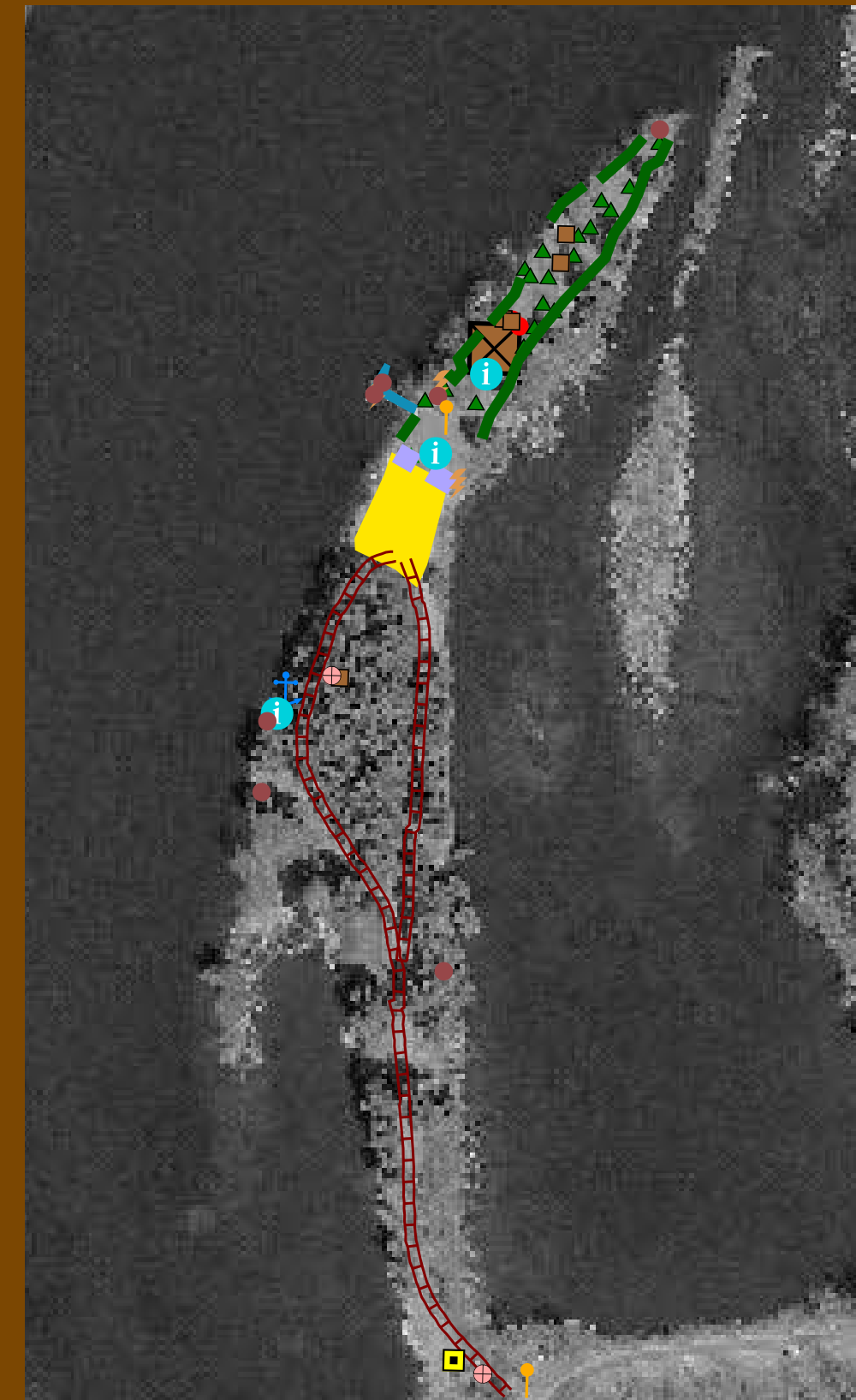


# Brauns Bay, Carson Park

Brauns Bay is a small peninsula located in Carson Park, on Half Moon Lake. Area mapped using GPS on March 21, 2001. It was a clear sunny day, but PDOPs were high. Brauns Bay is an ideal picnic site for groups with multiple activities planned. It boasts a boat landing and a dock, and has multiple landing sites along the west shore. There is one main pavillion with multiple picnic tables and several other picnic tables located throughout the site. The main drawback is the primitive road, which has many potholes. Due to the dense tree cover, the road and treelines had to be approximated from the data.
